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

LaTech /LPSS GEAR UP Partnership for SEL Support

Project Offerings

Louisiana Tech will provide Graduate-level credit courses on Social and Emotional Learning for up to 30 teachers and counselors. GEAR UP and LaTech will cover the cost of the course. The social and emotional needs of the students, teachers, and caretakers in the current GEAR UP cohort will be covered through a series of custom activities and outreach experiences provided by LaTech faculty and staff.

Quarterly SEL Workshops

LaTech will offer virtual workshops or minicamps for parents and students, based survey data gathered to evaluate student and parent needs.

Working Together to Support the Whole Student

Quarterly SEL Talks for Stakeholders

Up to 100 counselors, teachers, and other stakeholders will be able to join in on virtual SEL talks with experts in the area of mental health.

Scholarships/ Tuition Support for SEL Graduate Course

LaTech will provide \$800 scholarships for up to 30 teachers and counselors who would be willing to take a graduate course on Social and Emotional Learning. GEAR UP will cover the \$350 balance.






